## Getting There

Dubai International Airport is a major aviation hub in the Middle East, and is the main airport in Dubai. It offers an excellent selection of direct overseas routes on the world's largest airlines along with convenient international banking, forex and car rental services. The Taj Exotica Resort & Spa offers airport transfers via limousine and speedboat.

## Visas

In order to visit Dubai, you need a visa and passport that is valid for a minimum of 2 months from the date of your arrival. The embassy only issues visas for diplomatic or certain business visits. For routine travel, visas for tourists and travellers must be arranged via the sponsor. The sponsor may be the hotel, a tour operator, UAE resident or company.

## Climate

Dubai has an arid climate with year-round sunshine and infrequent, low rainfall. Average temperatures range from a low of about 10°C to a high of 48°C. Lightweight summer clothing is recommended for the day, although you may need a cardigan once the sun goes down.

## Currency

The national currency is the Arab Emirate Dirham, which is divided into 100 Fils. Traveller's cheques are easy to cash and Visa and MasterCard credit cards are accepted at most places.

## Language

The national language in UAE is Arabic but English is widely spoken and different regional languages are also used.

## Travel Tips

The UAE is one of the few countries with no reported cases of holiday illnesses recorded. No special immunizations are required. However, you should check beforehand if you are travelling from a health-risk area. The sun is strong throughout the year and heatstroke and heat exhaustion are always a risk. Sunglasses, hats and high factor sun blocks are essential, especially for children.
